

COMMUNITY ART PROJECT



The mural in front of Cathedral Kitchen's building has been designed by Kay Klotzbach, local artist and professor of art at Camden County College. Her organic design includes a combination of tile, glass and mirror. She has collaborated with Joe Brenman, a Philadelphia mural artist on the project. The tiles were designed by our dinner guests, staff and board

members during tile workshops in the summer of 2008. The mural itself was further developed and executed by Professor Klotzbach's students and college staff members as part of a service learning class held in the fall of 2008.

The mural design symbols include: the dove, signifying peace and love; the shell, representing a plate and the continuous circle of life; the plant forms, which are organic and life sustaining; and the knife, fork and spoon, integral to the meal representing man, sustenance and civility; and the water in the blue background that represents creation and the source of life.
