




Project Smiles Dental Clinic

12 dentists volunteered a total of 378 hours, which translates to more than \$52,920 in savings for the Kitchen.


2018 Guest Survey

food CK provides can save a family of four an average of \$645 per month and a single adult an average of \$168 per month. These dollars can be redirected towards other expenses, such as utilities, rent, medical bills, and education.
